Administration Updates

For the Fiscal Year 2018 Funds, the last day to turn in applications is Monday Sept. 24. Applies to the following benefits: Emergency Assistance, TCR, HUD, and Funeral Attendance. It is also the last day to apply for an advance for the Back to School Clothing Benefit.

September 29 is the UW versus BYU game. Raffle submissions are due by September 14.

If you are not already registered to vote in Washington State, October 8, 2018 is the deadline for online and mail-in voter registration, all address changes, name changes, and other updates. After this date, voters will need to register in-person by October 29 in order to vote in the November 6, 2018 general election. To register online to vote, visit sos.wa.gov
